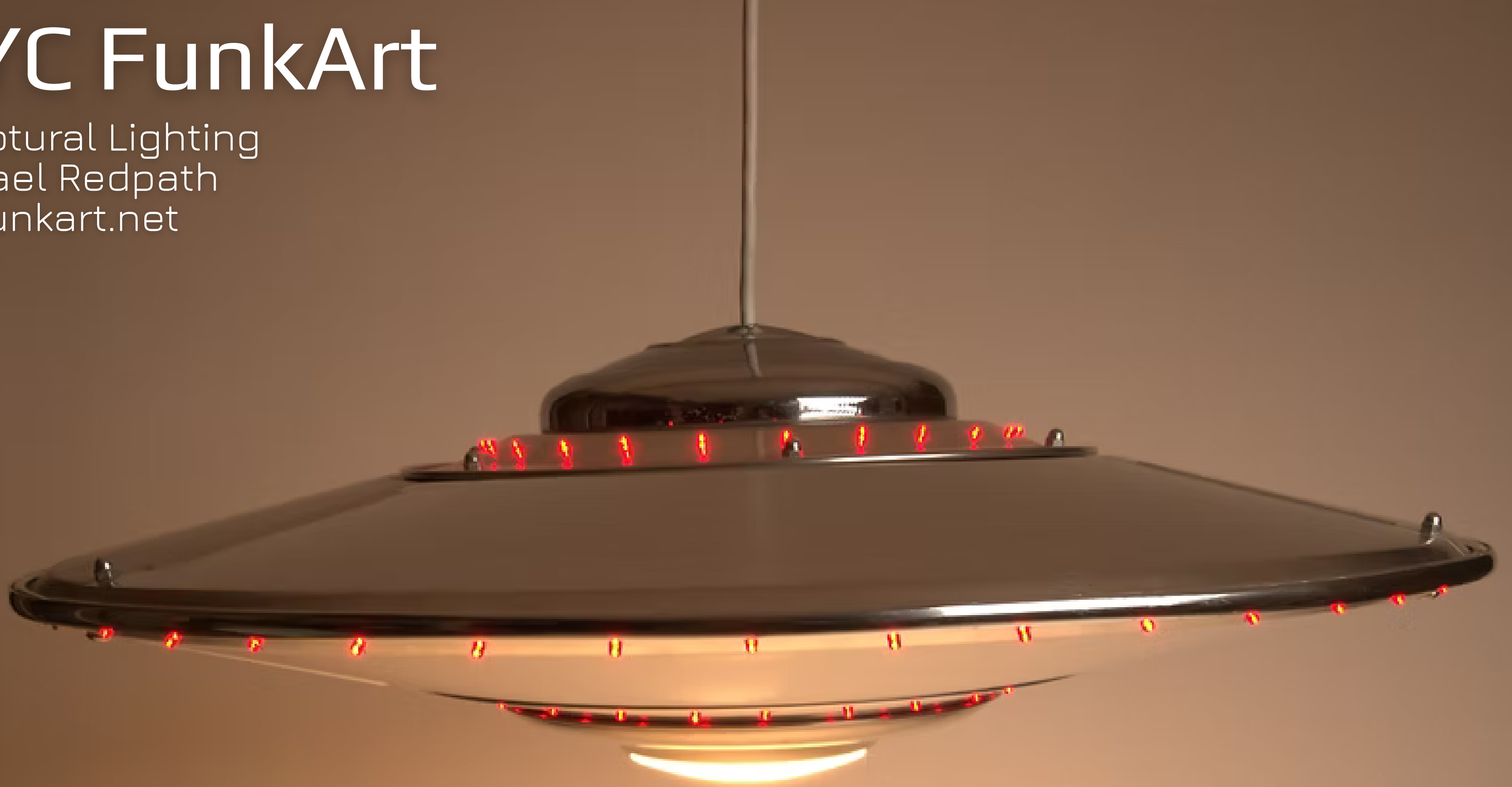

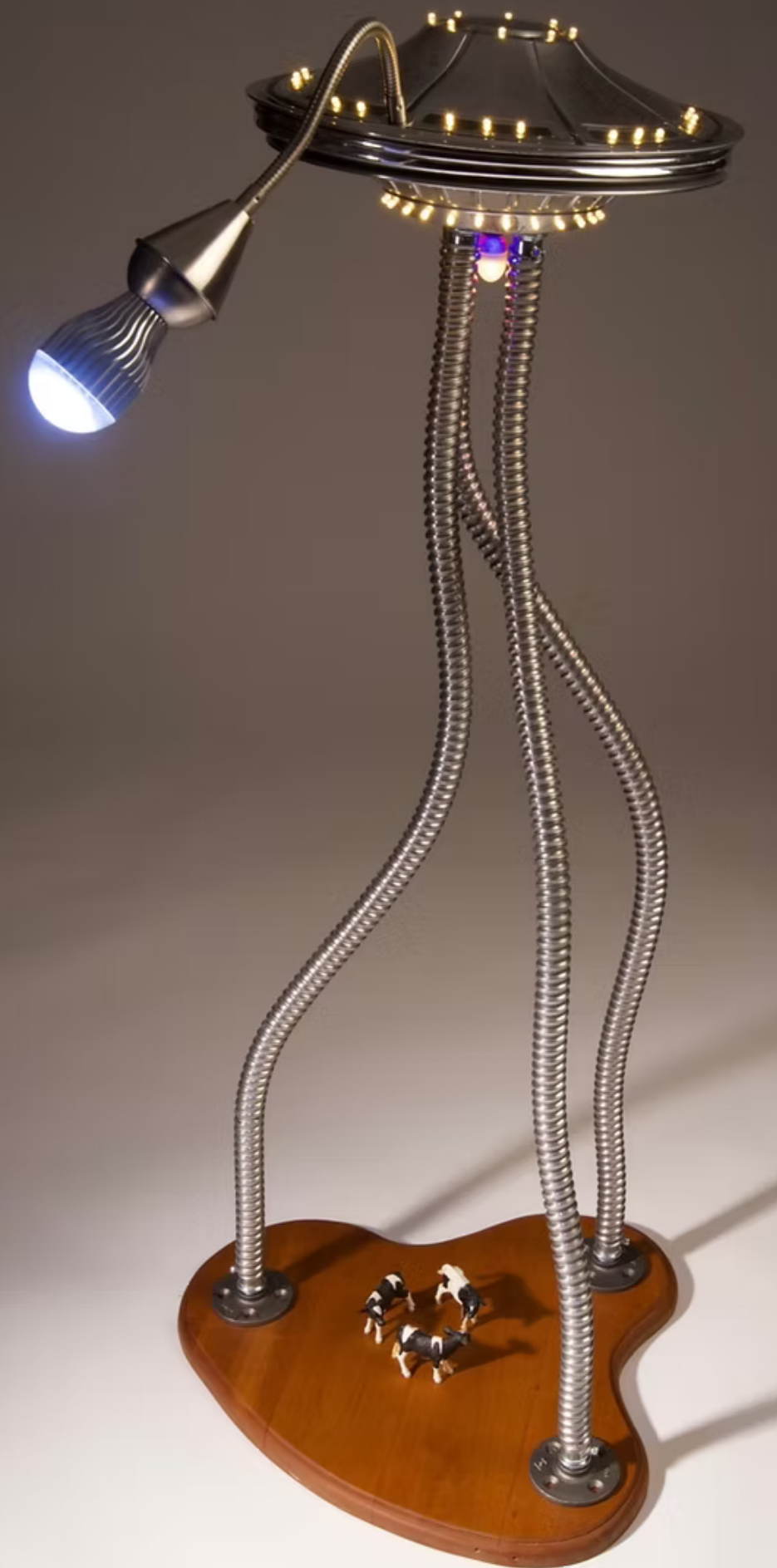




NYC FunkArt is the sculptural lighting collection of New York artist Michael Redpath. Using salvaged American automobile hubcaps and reclaimed industrial metal, Redpath creates one-of-a-kind handcrafted lighting that merges industrial materials with contemporary sculpture.

The collection includes wall-mounted lighting, suspended fixtures, floor lamps, desk lamps, and large-scale statement pieces for homes, galleries, restaurants, and modern interiors.

Influenced by the visual language of infrastructure, transportation, and illuminated architecture, each work is designed to function as both light source and sculpture. Every piece is individually fabricated, resulting in distinctive works that transform spaces through form, material and light.





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Michael Redpath is a New York artist, designer, and fabricator whose work explores the intersection of sculpture, lighting, and industrial design. Working primarily with reclaimed automotive and industrial materials, he creates one-of-a-kind illuminated sculptures that combine functional purpose with strong visual presence. Prior to his sculptural lighting, Redpath developed a collection of functional furniture that received recognition in publications including The New York Times and Home & Garden.

Through NYC FunkArt, he continues to create handcrafted works that transform salvaged materials into distinctive contemporary lighting for residential, commercial, and gallery environments.
